Short-term (0-2 years):

- Establish mechanisms for regular feedback on teaching quality.

Medium-term (2-5 years):

- Develop flexible course options and credit-based systems.
- Establish dedicated training programs for faculty development.

Long-term (5-10 years):

- Launch internationally competitive curricula.
- Encourage the creation of Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs).

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3. Research and Innovation

Short-term (0-2 years):

Medium-term (2-5 years):

- Collaborate with industries and other institutions for joint research.
- Strengthen the existing innovation and incubation cell to support start-ups.
- Encourage faculty to pursue higher education, certifications, and attend workshops and conferences.

Long-term (5-10 years):

- Monetize research outcomes through technology transfer and commercialization.
- Create specialized research labs and infrastructure for innovation.

4. Physical and Digital Infrastructure

Objective: Develop sustainable and inclusive infrastructure.

Short-term (0-2 years):

- Conduct a needs assessment for campus infrastructure.
- Implement green campus initiatives such as renewable energy and waste management.

Medium-term (2-5 years):

- Upgrade ICT infrastructure for digital learning.
- Enhance physical facilities, including smart classrooms and advanced laboratories.

Long-term (5-10 years):

- Develop a fully accessible campus with provisions for persons with disabilities.
- Establish a centralized digital repository and data management system.

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5. Community and Industry Engagement

Short-term (0-2 years):

Short-term (0-2 years):

Long-term (5-10 years):

1. IDP Strategy Team
