






#### A GUEST TALK ON APPLICATIONS OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY IN INVENTORY MANAGEMENT

Participants gained insights into career opportunities in science, ancient Indian scientists, and the importance of research in national development. MEDIA VISIT TO PRESS CLUB (APRIL 12, 2025):



# NEXUS 2024























सभी सरकारी अधिकारियों को दफ्तरों में अंग्रेजी के साथ-साथ हिंदी का उपयोग अनिवार्य बनाया गया है | आदेश, नियम, अधिसूचना, प्रतिवेदन , प्रेस विज्ञप्ति, निविदा, अनुबंध व विभिन्न प्रारूपण को हिंदी में बनाना और जारी करना अनिवार्य है | इसका सीधा सा अर्थ है कि केंद्र सरकार व राज्य सरकारों के सभी विभागों ,उपविभागों में हिंदी अधिकारी अनुवादक, प्रबंधक, उप प्रबंधक हिंदी ज्ञाता के रूप में रखे जा रहे हैं | सभी राष्ट्रीयकृत बैंकों में हिंदी अधिकारी के पद बनाए गए हैं। आज हिंदी भाषा के बढ़ते चलन और वैश्विक रूप में रोजगार की अनेक संभावनाओं को उजागर किया है। इसकी विविध क्षेत्रों में स्वीकृति और प्रयोजनियत्ता बढ़ने से नई दृष्टि से हिंदी को देखा जा रहा है।

#### योग और चिकित्सा के क्षेत्र में रोजगार-

#### हिंदी राजभाषा अधिकारी -

केंद्रीय संस्थानों और कार्यालयों में राजभाषा अधिकारी की नियुक्ति की जाती है, जो अपने यहां पर हिंदी के प्रयोग को हर तरह से बढ़ावा देते हैं और हिंदी में कामकाज को सुगम बनाते हैं | यदि आप हिंदी विषय में स्नातक हो और एक विषय के रूप में अंग्रेजी विषय भी पढ़ा है, तो राजभाषा अधिकारी के रूप में कैरियर बनाया जा सकता है |सभी सरकारी अधिकारियों के दफ्तर में अंग्रेजी के साथ-साथ हिंदी का उपयोग अनिवार्य बनाया गया

#### टाइपिंग के क्षेत्र में रोजगार-

#### रेडियो जॉकी के क्षेत्र में रोजगार

आज हिंदी में रेडियो जॉकी के क्षेत्र में रोजगारों की संभावनाएं बहुत अच्छी है | क्योंकि रेडियो में ज्यादातर सरल हिंदी में ही प्रस्तुतीकरण होता है | विद्यार्थी अपनी सहजवाणी, माधुर्य भाषा प्रवाहमयता ,बातचीत और आकर्षक अंदाज के साथ इसमें काम कर सकता है और रोजगार पा सकता है|

#### संगीत संबंधी रोजगार -

आजकल हमारे देश के युवाओं में हिंदी भाषा के माध्यम से म्यूजिक बैंड बनाने और परफॉर्म करने का ट्रेड बहुत जोर पकड़ रहा है | स्कूल कॉलेज और छोटे स्तरों पर इस प्रकार के सैकड़ो हजारों पेंट्स आज अस्तित्व में आ गये जो मनुष्य को रोजी-रोटी देते हैं और बहुत सारे लोग ऐसे हैं जो कम पढ़े लिखे हैं, लेकिन संगीत जानते हैं और इसके सहारे अपने परिवार चलाते हैं। संगीत का दायरा आजकल सीमित नहीं है |

#### हस्तलिपि में रोजगार (ग्राफ़ोलॉजी) -

यह एक ऐसा प्रोफेशन है जिसमें हैंडराइटिंग के माध्यम से किसी भी व्यक्ति के बुनियादी चिरत्र को सामने लाना होता है | यह प्रोफेशन लोगों की भविष्यवाणी तो नहीं करता और न हीं बीते हुए समय के बारे में जानकारी देता हैं | इस कला का उपयोग केवल स्वयं को समझने, सुधारने और लोगों की सोच, व्यवहार को जाने एवं व्यक्तित्व की रूपरेखा को समझने के लिए किया जाता है |

#### काउंसलिंग संबंधी रोजगार-

इस विधा के माध्यम से उपयुक्त राय देने और व्यक्ति को उसमें निहित गुण - दोष से परिचित कराने का प्रयत्न किया जाता है | ऐसे एक्सपर्ट को जांच दल का हिस्सा माना जाता है अधिकांश विभागों में ऐसे पदों का सर्जन किया गया है हैंडराइटिंग किसी भी व्यक्ति को जानने का एक माध्यम हो सकती है

#### विदेशी कार्यक्रम में रोजगार के अवसर -

आजकल टीवी के माध्यम से बहुत सारे ऐसे चैनल दिखाए जा रहे हैं, जो हिंदी से अंग्रेजी में और अंग्रेजी से हिंदी में दिखाए जाते हैं। जैसे डिस्कवरी चैनल, नेशनल जियोग्राफी चैनल, एनिमल प्लेनेट, हिस्ट्री चैनल और फॉक्स ट्रैवलर ही नहीं कई विदेशी चैनल पर फिल्मी कार्टून सीरियल हिंदी में अनु सृजन के कारण अब लोकप्रिय क्षेत्र बन चुके हैं

#### हिंदी वेब पत्रकारिता में रोजगार-

हिंदी पत्रकारिता ने हिंदी के कारोबार को अच्छा खासा बढ़ावा दिया है | दिल्ली के कुछ कॉलेज में ये विषय लोकप्रिय भी है | आने वाले समय में हिंदी को वैश्विक भाषा बनाने की दिशा में और काम करने की जरूरत है। इससे लोगों को हिंदी से संबंधित तरह-तरह के रोजगार के नए अवसर उपलब्ध हो रहे हैं |

#### दूरदर्शन में रोजगार के अवसर -

वर्तमान में दूरदर्शन 28 क्षेत्रीय चैनल सहित 36 टीवी चैनलों का संचालन करता है और आकाशवाणी 500 से अधिक प्रसारण केंन्द्रों का संचालन करता है| यह योजना देश में एयर एफएम ट्रांसमित्रों के कवरेज को भौगोलिक क्षेत्र के अनुसार 59% से बढ़कर 66% और आबादी के हिसाब से 68% बढ़कर 80% कर देगी|

#### कंप्यूटर के क्षेत्र में रोजगार -

आज का युग कंप्यूटर का युग है। हिंदी के विद्यार्थी इस क्षेत्र में भी अपना केरियर बना सकते हैं। वर्तमान में प्रिंट मीडिया, इलेक्ट्रॉनिक मीडिया, इंटरनेट आदि में राष्ट्रीय और अंतरराष्ट्रीय मंच और संस्थाओं में हिंदी के इस्तेमाल में व्यापक वृद्धि हुई है। फेसबुक, ट्विटर, यूट्यूब, व्हाट्सएप जैसे प्लेटफार्म पर हिंदी का प्रभाव बढ़ता जा रहा। गूगल और माइक्रोसॉफ्ट जैसी दिग्गज कंपनी ने भी हिंदी में बहुत बड़े पैमाने पर काम करना शुरू कर दिया है

**ऑडियो- वीडियो विजुअल में प्रयोग-** आजकल हिंदी में अनेक विविध प्रकार की कहानियां, चुटकुले, कविताएं पूछो तो जानें, समाचार, संगीत सुनने और दिखाने वाले ऑडियो विजुअल एप भी बाजार में आ चुके हैं |ऑडियो विजुअल एप हिंदी के अलावा क्षेत्रीय भाषा में भी सामग्री उपलब्ध करा रहे हैं। यह ऐप यूजर को खुद कंटेंट देने और पैसा कमाने का मौका भी देती है।

अत: हम दावे के साथ कह सकते हैं कि हिंदी भाषा आज केवल पढ़ने, लिखने और बोलने तक की सीमित भाषा नहीं रही, आज इसका वैश्वीकरण हो चुका है | पूरे विश्व में यह भाषा अपने पैर पसार चुकी है और निरंतर अपने कदम आगे बढाती हुई रोजगा का साधन बन चुकी है ||




